Choir is Thurs., Dec. 17, from 3:00 to 3:45.

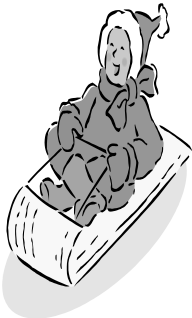

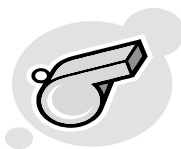
CHRISTMAS VACATION
