

# St. Mary's School Photo Identification Exclusion

Students at St. Mary's School may on occasion appear in photographs or videotapes taken by school personnel, other students, or other individuals authorized by the principal. The school may use these images, without identifying the student or students, for academic, informational, or promotional purposes. These images may appear in places such as the school website, school videos, the school yearbook, and school newsletters.

St. Mary's School has traditionally allowed printing of students' images in the local news media as well as in its own publications. Many times, St. Mary's will want to identify students in school photographs. St. Mary's wants to acknowledge those students who have participated in a special event or who have received special recognition. These images would most likely appear in the Breeze Courier, Catholic Times, taylorvilledailynews.com or other area news publication. The images could be in print and/or on a website.

St. Mary's recognizes that not all families wish to have their children identified by name in the media. The purpose of this form is to provide you with the opportunity to exclude your child(ren) from any photo or video in which students will be identified by name.
