

ST. MARY SCHOOL BOOSTER CLUB

The Booster Club is a support group for St. Mary's School. Membership is open to all members of the parish. The main purpose of the Booster Club is to plan fund raising projects to help alleviate some of the financial burden of the school from the parish. These fund raising projects should have a definite purpose in mind before they are undertaken.

The Booster Club officers will present a budget to the club at the first meeting of the school year detailing past year's expenditures and proposed goals for the current year. This budget will be voted on and approved by the club members.

The Booster Club will contribute to the budget of the school in whatever areas are deemed feasible. These may include equipment, supplies, salaries or books.

St. Mary's Booster Club By-Laws

ARTICLE I – NAME

The name of this organization shall be St. Mary's Booster Club.

ARTICLE II – OBJECTIVE

The objectives of this club are: To unite our members in bonds of friendship, good will and mutual understanding; **to provide extra funds for our school**; to inform and educate the members as to the educational programs of our school; to promote an active interest in the social affairs of the Club and the school.

ARTICLE III – MEMBERSHIP

The membership is open to all parents of St. Mary's School children and teachers and any parish member.

ARTICLE IV – MEETINGS

Section 1. The Executive Board meets monthly, with all parents welcome. There will be four required meetings throughout the year, with matters of importance requiring vote at the September, November, February, and May meetings.

Section 2. The President has the power to call emergency meetings, with all parents and all officers to be notified.

ARTICLE V – OFFICERS

Section 1. The Spiritual Director shall be the Pastor.

Section 2. The elected officers shall be President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer.

Section 3. Term of office shall be one year – September 1 through August 31. No elected officer shall hold the same title for more than two consecutive terms.

Section 4. The Pastor and elected officers shall be empowered to fill any vacancies for the balance of the term.

ARTICLE VI – ELECTION OF OFFICERS

Section 1. The Nominating Committee for officers of the ensuing year shall be appointed by the President and approved by the majority at the February meeting.

Section 2. The Nominating Committee shall consist of three members.

Section 3. The Nominating Committee shall meet in April with the Pastor as advisor, prior to the May meeting of the Club.

Section 4. The Nominating Committee shall present a complete slate of officers at the May meeting. There must be three candidates for each office.
