Before/After Care

Bills for Before & After Care will be sent on May 19. This will include everything owed through May 18.

From May 19—25 you may pay day by day or for the amount of days you know you'll use. These are 2:15 dismissal days so After Care is \$7 per child. Before Care is always \$1 per child.

After Care is available thru 5:30 on May 25. Please pay in full by May 25 so that your child's report card will not be withheld on May 26.

Before Care is available thru May 26. No charge for Before Care for May 26, the last day of school. We will not offer After Care on May 26.

Ask your child if they got an IOU today! All accounts must be paid prior to the end of school, including tuition, IOU's, Before & After Care, book fines, and payment for lost library books. Tuition must be paid in full. Families using Smart Tuition must have current accounts. Reports cards are withheld until all is settled.
